It is our great pleasure to invite you to the 5<sup>th</sup> “Early Iron Age in Central Europe” international conference which is organised in cooperation with the society Orbis Ferrorum (AT) and the OÖ Landes-Kultur GmbH (AT) and will be hosted in Linz.

Scholars are invited to present the results of their studies on the Early Iron Age in Central Europe, with a particular focus on the Hallstatt and Early La Tène cultural zones – either as an oral presentation or a poster display.

The conference comprises two days of presentations (Mon–Tue) and a one-day outdoor excursion (Wed). Posters are presented during the breaks. A get-together will be organised on Sunday, an evening lecture on Monday, and social evenings on Monday and Tuesday.

We invite scholars to submit abstracts (max. 300 words) or a poster in portrait A1/A0 format. The conference registration form (attached) indicating your contribution proposal and the abstract/poster are to be sent to [team@orbisferrorum.com](mailto:team@orbisferrorum.com). A peer-reviewed publication is intended.

**The call for papers is now open and ends on 22 April 2024.**

The official languages are English and German. Please note that the PowerPoint presentations (or other) and posters should be prepared in English and the sessions are chaired in English as well. We kindly ask the speakers not to exceed a limit of 20 minutes for their presentations which will be followed by a short discussion.

The conference fee is € 50 (€ 25 for students) and can be paid via bank transfer or upon arrival. It covers excursion expenses, conference materials, and coffee breaks.

Concerning accommodation, contingents will be pre-booked in three different price categories. Alternatively, you can contact Linz Tourismus.
